- READ *Piggy Pie Po* by Audrey and Don Wood - [hoopladigital.com/title/12029758](http://hoopladigital.com/title/12029758)
- TALK Practicing animal sounds helps babies hear the different sounds that make up a word. Hearing all those sounds help them as they learn to talk and to read. Start with what does the pig say? What do other animals say? Go through the farm and think of animals and sounds they make.
- SING This is a fun song about getting muddy! "Five Little Pigs Roll in the Mud" <https://youtu.be/o-QSluel4fg>
- WRITE Find five toys or objects that are baby friendly and put them in front of your baby. Sing the Five Little Pigs Roll in the Mud again and have the baby move one object each time from the "mud."
- PLAY To play with this familiar rhyme you need your little toes free from socks and shoes. Wiggle one toe for each line, starting with the big toe and ending with the littlest. On the last toe as the piggy goes home give the baby a tickle from toe to head as the piggy goes home.

*This little piggy stayed home*

*This little piggy had roast beef*

*This little piggy had none*

*And this little piggy went wee wee wee all the way home!*
