- READ *10 Rules of Being a Superhero* by Deb Pilutti <https://bit.ly/3b84ltK>
- TALK/WRITE Talk about the characters in the book and their superpowers. What superpowers does Captain Magma have? What about Lava Boy? Ask your child what superpowers they would like to have. Sometimes superpowers are more ordinary than you might think. Talk with your child about everyday superpowers and everyday heroes. Have your child draw a picture of superheroes with powers you talked about.
- SING Here's a fun finger play called "5 Superheroes" <https://bit.ly/3c5nMEO>
You can use your fingers to count down, or bring out some action figures, dolls, or stuffed animals to be the superheroes. Don't forget the villain!
*5 superheroes ready to fly
Here comes the villain. Stop that guy!
This superhero can save the day. Off he flies - up, up, and away!*
(Repeat, counting down from 4, 3, 2, and 1)
